### What Are Degree Breadth Electives (DBEs)?

- Provincially Mandated
- Integral Part of All Degree Programs
- Distinct from Program of Study
- 3 Categories:
  - 1. Arts & Humanities (History, Art Appreciation, Philosophy, etc.)
  - 2. Society, Culture & Commerce (Sociology, Cultural Studies, etc.)
  - 3. Science & Technology (Environmental Studies, Astronomy, etc.)
- 2 Levels:
  - 1. Lower Level (LL)
  - 2. Upper Level (UL)
- Students must complete at least 2 LL DBEs in 2 different categories and at least 2 UL DBEs in 2 different categories. The remaining DBEs can be in any category and at any level.

- Be sure to check the campus, day & time, and delivery mode





### **Registering for DBEs: Best Practices**

- Take your DBEs when they are scheduled. (Taking them later or earlier may result in extra fees.)
- Register as soon as you can. (The earlier you do, the more options you'll have.)
- Register before the last day to add (Monday, September 08).
- Take 2 or 3 LL DBEs before taking your UL DBEs.
- If the DBE you want is full or restricted, self-register in a different DBE even if it is not your preferred course, day/time, or mode of delivery.
   (This way, you will stay on track.)
- Come to the FLAS Office (MED Building 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor) if you need help finding an available DBE. (We can't overenroll courses or override restrictions, but we can show you how to find unrestricted DBEs that still have seats.)
